FOURTH OF JULY CELEBRATION 2023

Background Information

- Prior to the Great Recession, the City organized a Fourth of July fireworks show and Festival at Bayfront Park and Fernandez Park.
- The Fourth of July celebration included a festival in the park prior to the fireworks show. Activities included food vendors, music and children's activities
- Funding for the Fourth of July fireworks show and festival was eliminated due to the economic downturn.

Background Information

- In 2021, the City Council discussed the return of a Fourth of July celebration.
- In 2022, staff provided Council with options for a City-sponsored fireworks show.
- The City Council directed staff to partner with the City of Hercules for a joint 2022 Fourth of July fireworks show.

Background Information Continued

- The joint 2022 Fourth of July fireworks show was launched from land near the Hercules bayfront.
- The 20 minute show included shells ranging from three inches to six inches which went up 300 to 600 feet in the air.
- The cost of the fireworks show, not including staff time, was \$25,243. This cost was Pinole's contribution to the overall cost of the show which came out to about a 50% share.
- The fireworks show was not visible from Fernandez Park as expected and visibility was low from Bayfront Park.

Fireworks Show in Pinole

- Small scale fireworks show
- Location could be Bayfront Park, Fernandez Park, PVHS athletic facilities or Pinole Valley Park.
- •\$25,000 minimum

Fireworks Show in Pinole

- Large scale fireworks show
- Location would be Bayfront Park
- •\$40,000 estimate

Joint Fireworks Show

- Collaboration with the City of Hercules
- Same location as last year (Hercules waterfront)
- Cost would be split evenly between the two cities
- City would advertise viewing locations in Hercules

Drone Light Show

- Drone show that goes 150-400 feet in the air
- Location could be Fernandez Park, PVHS athletic facilities, Pinole Valley Park, Other?
- Not to exceed \$50,000

- •Drone Light Show \$63, 153
- Joint Fireworks Show \$51,000 (estimate)

Cost Information Continued

- Council has allocated \$100,000 for unspecified community events in the FY 2022/23 budget.
- \$26, 589 has been expended on the 2022 fireworks show and 2022 United Against Hate event.
- Staff expects to use an estimated \$5,000 for the 2023 Earth Day event and Egg Hunt.
- \$68, 410 would be available for community events offered in FY 2022/23.
