I would like to give you an update on the status of Pinole Library and an overview of the services and programs we are providing at this time.

Our number of visitors at the newly reopened Pinole Library branch is steadily increasing every week, as more and more of our patrons hear the good news that their local community library has returned to its regular operation. We have daily visitors that stay at the library for hours at a time, utilizing it for their quiet work needs. We are waiting to see if the start of the school year at Pinole Valley High next week brings back our after-school crowds as well.

Patrons are utilizing the branch for many reasons - several people have come in to make use of our high-end microfilm machine for research projects, educators are coming in to gather books for their classrooms, our internet-enabled computers are a welcome service to regulars and visitors alike, and people are happy to be able to browse our collections again.

While we aren't yet hosting library-sponsored programs, our meeting room is available for rentals by third parties and has been booked for an auction later this month on Saturday, August 28th.

We are promoting the countywide events scheduled by Contra Costa County Library as well as our neighboring libraries. The Master Gardener series dovetails nicely with our new free seed library, a collaboration with the Pinole Garden Club. Free Comic Book Week events are happening the week of August 16th through the 21st, and everyone in the county is welcome to participate in the series of online talks and workshops and is encouraged to stop by the library branch to choose from a collection of free comics and grab a goodie bag.
