
COOKIES AND CANVAS AT THE YOUTH CENTER – MAY 13TH

APRIL IS SEXUAL ASSAULT AWARENESS MONTH

April of each year is designated as Sexual Assault Awareness Month. Activities include rallies and marches to draw attention to the issues surrounding sexual assault as well as events honoring those who are heroes in the movement against sexual assault.

The local Rape Crisis Center/Community Violence Solutions joins with centers worldwide to run a Denim Day campaign on a Wednesday in April in honor of Sexual Assault Awareness Month. The campaign was originally triggered by a ruling by the Italian Supreme Court where a rape conviction was overturned because the justices felt that since the victim was wearing tight jeans she must have helped her rapist remove her jeans, thereby implying consent. The following day, the women in the Italian Parliament came to work wearing jeans in solidarity with the victim. The Peace Over Violence organization developed the Denim Day campaign in response to this case and the activism surrounding it. Since then, wearing jeans on Denim Day has become a symbol of protest against erroneous and destructive attitudes about sexual assault. During this rape prevention education campaign community members, elected officials, businesses and students are asked to make a social statement with their fashion by wearing jeans on this day as a visible means of protest against the misconceptions that surround sexual assault. This year's Denim Day is Wednesday, April 26, 2017.



MTC RELEASED DRAFT PLAN BAY AREA 2040

The Draft Plan Bay Area 2040 is an updated Regional Transportation Plan and Sustainable Communities Strategy for the nine-county San Francisco Bay Area. It discusses how the Bay Area will grow over the next two decades and identifies transportation and land use strategies to enable a more sustainable, equitable and economically vibrant future. Starting with the current state of the region, this document describes Plan Bay Area 2040 and its goals, a proposed growth pattern and supporting transportation investment strategy, and key actions needed to address ongoing and long-term regional challenges.

• E-CIGARETTES ADDED TO THE DEFINITION OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS

Tuesday night the City Council adopted an amendment to our Municipal Code to include e-cigarettes under the definition of tobacco products. What that does for the community is clears up any confusion regarding how e-cigarettes can be utilized in public areas. The same restrictions on "smoking" in public spaces are applicable to e-cigarettes – so they are prohibited at all of the City's parks, trails and open spaces.


