• <u>CITY COUNCIL VOTES TO JOIN MARIN CLEAN ENGERY</u>

At their June 6th meeting the City Council voted 4-1 to unite with Contra Costa County and several other cities in the County to join Marin Clean Energy (MCE). This means that all of our current PG&E electricity customers will be enrolled in MCE by the Spring of 2018. All customers will be provided with five (5) mailers advising who MCE is, what they do, and what you can do if you wish to opt-out and remain with PG&E for your electricity service provider. There is an initial 60-day window period to opt-out for no fee. After that there is a one-time \$5 fee for residential customers and \$25 for commercial customers.

MCE offers electricity generated by renewable/clean energy sources at a higher level than PG&E currently offers standard customers, at approximately 54%. Both MCE and PG&E have plans where by customers can "buy up" to 100% renewable energy sources for an additional monthly fee.

Customers who decide to stay with MCE will not see any change in the appearance of their billing, except that the line for electricity generation will now say MCE rather than PG&E. However, PG&E will still provide the transmission lines for your energy, as well as your gas service. So PG&E remains your primary contact for service needs.


