CONSTRUCTION MANAGER'S CORNER

Work continued this period on the Gymnasium tilt-up walls with the first round completely lifted and with structural steel and roof decking placed. Lifting began on the Performing Arts building tilt-up walls surrounding the poured concrete walls and structural steel placed in the theater area. A deep drain between the upper campus classrooms was installed to help keep the site clear of groundwater and to prepare for future work in that area.



UPCOMING CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

- Continue excavation, rebar, and concrete placement of footings of second Classroom building.
- Second round of Gymnasium panel lifts (for main gym).
- Performing Arts building panel lifting continues.
- Classroom building mansard roof decking installed.
- Classroom building overhead ductwork and piping installation continues.

- Classroom building overhead ductwork, conduit, and piping installation on 2nd and 3rd floors.
- Footings of rear Classroom building excavated and rebar placed.
- Classroom building mansard roof framing installed.
