Mr. Rhodes reported that City staff approved two recent tree removal permit requests. One request was to remove a Coast Live Oak tree at 1521 Mann Drive due to interference with utilities. The second request was to remove two pine trees due to safety concerns and interference with utilities at 1240 Marionola Way. Mr. Rhodes was asked about a potential change to the tree removal ordinance. Mr. Rhodes discussed a request from a member of the public to modify City requirements relating to pine trees made at a City Council meeting earlier in the year. Staff mentioned that an informational item could be scheduled for future Planning Commission discussion at the next Planning Commission meeting.

Mr. Rhodes provided an update about the East Bay Regional Parking District (EBRPD) Bay Trail bridge project relating to the selection of the railing color to complement the natural setting and the previously approved bridge decking design. The meeting was held at Bayfront Park and the railing color selected was an army green. The bay trail project in Pinole is currently anticipated to be completed during the summer of 2018.

Staff also provided an update on a code enforcement case relating to a tree service business within the residential portion of Pinole Valley Road near the southern city limits.

Staff mentioned potential upcoming development projects were inquiries have been received including potential American Automobile Association (AAA) office and a California State Lottery office and warehouse.
