VERONICA TAM, Veronica Tam & Associates, presented the Final Draft of the 2015-2023 Housing Element and identified the City of Pinole's need to identify an adequate capacity for its share of the Regional Housing Needs Allocation (RHNA) of 297 units established by the Association of Bay Area Governments (ABAG) during the eight-year period; a goal for planning but not a production obligation, which would depend on the market and private development interests. She stated that under existing land use designations there are adequate capacity for the City to be able to accommodate those 297 units.

Ms. Tam reported that the State Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) had determined that the City's Draft Housing Element was in substantial compliance if adopted, as revised. The City Council would have to adopt the Housing Element by May 31, 2015 in order to comply with State law.

Ms. Tam referenced the Planning Commission's concern with respect to SB 1087, a requirement that affordable housing projects receive priority for the allocation of water and sewer services. Language in the document had been modified and accepted by the State given that the City had no control over water and only had indirect control over wastewater service in a portion of the City.
